 - ii. Human beings and creation
 - iii. Human beings and God

From Chapter 3:

- 1. How do we see God's grace in the midst of despair in (pages 49-50):
 - i. The serpent-crusher (Genesis 3:15)
 - ii. The marks of Cain (Genesis 4:15)
 - iii. Enoch walked with God (Genesis 5:24)

2. How does the explanation of "covenant" help you understand God's love and commitment to his people? (pages 51-52, figure 11).

From Chapter 4:
